

Sunday, November 29th – Christmas: Tree

This week at Kids Club, we talked about another group of people who shared in the wonder that was the first Christmas. In Luke 2:8, the Bible records that shepherds were living out in the field as they watched over their sheep when the angels told them about Jesus' birth.

Now, back in those days (2000 years ago), shepherds were treated really badly. People didn't trust them and wouldn't listen to them. But, God chose shepherds to be the ones who herd from the angels, and in turn, it was shepherds who started sharing the news of Jesus' birth. Like an arrow, the shepherds pointed to the miracle of Jesus.



Today, we looked at the Christmas Tree. Often, a Christmas tree is made up of 3 arrows pointing up into the sky. We can use them to remember that we are called to be like the shepherds and point to Jesus through the way that we live our lives – what we do, what we say and how we think.
