Sermon Title: Blessed – are the peacemakers.

Message: Jeremy Rensford.

Big Idea/Sermon focus:

- Jesus told us that we are blessed if we *make* peace (as opposed to “keeping” the peace). It’s not easy for us, but *His* way works and the rewards are great.

Message / key study scripture: Matthew 18:15

- Carefully read this verse and consider Jesus’ teaching here and its implications:
 - Jesus says “if” (your brother sins against you), could he have used the word “when” instead? Why?
 - Jesus uses the word “go”. How is this consistent with Jeremy’s sermon?
 - What’s the significance and ramifications of “just between the two of you”?
 - Discuss the results of obeying this verse according to Jesus’s teaching?

- What, if anything, needs to change?
