Sermon Title: Games with God – Simon Says.

Big Idea/Sermon focus:

Some think that being a Christian is a bit like a game of “Simon says” - or “Jesus says” where He gives commands and instructions that are confusing and impossible – it’s so hard to play and easy to get “out”.

- (from last week’s sermon) – Are you staying in touch with Jesus during times of sinning or playing hide and seek?
