Sermon Title: Where are we now?

Big Idea/Sermon focus:

What a previous twelve months it's been! For many, it has caused us to reflect and take stock of things. In God we are to mature and be moving forward, otherwise we are going backwards.

Message / key study Scriptures: 1 Corinthians 14:20

- In this week's sermon and this Scripture, we see that God's Word seems to equate a lack of spiritual maturity with sin/evil and unrighteousness. Why do you think this is the case?
- What does a child think like? Why are we to stop being like this?
- What do you think this part of the verse means: "In regard to evil, be infants"?

Questions:

- *Ask those who have known the Lord more than five years:* Let's cut to the chase, are you currently sucking the milk or giving the milk? (it may pay to ask those that know the person well what they think – if not causing too much conflict).
- *For newer Christians:* who has been providing you with milk? What's the next step in the growth of your spiritual diet look like?
- *Getting to know each other more personally:* why have you answered the way you have? Take us more deeply into a struggle or a victory that has caused you to answer the way you have.
